
Formally he has taught CXC and CAPE at Dinthill Technical High School for a year. He has more than fourteen (14) years' experience as a part-time lecturer for a number of mathematics related courses at the University of the West Indies and Northern Caribbean University. He still lectures at the latter. These courses include Fundamentals of Mathematics, College Algebra, Calculus, Statistics and Quantitative Methods. During this time he has achieved an enviable track record of pass rate consistently over 80 percent and sometimes 100%, a rear feat for Mathematical courses.

According to the Ministry of Education website, the pass rate for cxc mathematics in 2012 and 2013 were 31.7% and 34.1% respectively. This means *LESS THAN 35 OUT OF EVERY 100 STUDENTS GET A PASSING GRADE* in those two years.

One of the aims of The Math Professor is to improve this statistic.

Lecturing at the Universities Mr. Hunter became very knowledgeable of the mathematical deficiencies of students leaving the High School system. By focusing on these areas of deficiencies (which for the most part are not on the university syllabus) and applying his own unique style of teaching, he has been able to achieve the remarkable results that he has with the university students.

He now sees the need to take on more CXC mathematics students, making them better equipped for university and the world of work and in so doing, playing his part in improving the national average in passes for CXC mathematics.



He is also an Electrical Engineer, a career which requires very in-depth study of mathematics. He has a Master's degree in Business Administration, a Bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering and a Certificate in teaching, among other qualifications.
